Accessing the Emergency and Electronic Connections





Once a corner of the reflector is freed from the channel, slide the screwdriver towards the other end of the housing to release the reflector.

***Make sure to support the reflector with both hands.





While supporting the reflector, plug in the test switch.



To insert the reflector, align the reflector tabs with the channel cover support. Be sure that the tabs are fully inserted before moving to the next step. On the opposite side, carefully roll and press the reflector back into the housing.

*** Pinch Hazard: Take caution while pressing near the seam or edge of the reflector.

Once the fixture is installed, make sure the basket securely installed and the up light film is tucked.





To remove the basket, grip the basket towards the end of the fixture. Rotate and Unhook the basket from the light traps. Store basket in a safe location where it will get damaged. Reverse the steps to reinstall.





When the basket is installed, insert film back into basket. This can be done by sliding your hands along the length of the basket while tucking the film under the lip of the basket





To gain access inside the channel, gently push upwards on the reflector with the test switch present until the notch in the reflector is visible. Insert a screwdriver into the notch to pry and wedge open.
