# **IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Read all instructions prior to installing this product.
- 2. Turn off electrical power and allow luminaire & lamp to cool before servicing and/or replacing lamp.
- 3. Replace lamp only with 12V Halogen Bi-pin Lamp as labeled on the fixture.
- 4. Connect this product only to a 120V 60hz electrical supply.
- 5. Install this product only in dry or damp locations. Do not install in wet locations.

Note: This product is intended to be installed in accordance with national and/or local electrical codes. Check with a qualified electrician prior to installing.



# SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

#### INSTALLATION

- 1 Install mounting plate using (2) screws provided. Pull the (2) wires from the remote transformer out through center hole of mounting plate.
- Connect the (2) wires of the remote transformer to the (2) wires of the Quick Jack connector.
- Push these wire nut connections up into the iunction box.
- Push canopy up into place. Secure with (2) knurled nuts provided.
- 5 Push Quick Jack of the fixture into Quick Jack connector and tighten firmly.
- Turn power ON.
